This APBA Regional Watercross racing and Freestyle event will take place at Wooten Park, located in downtown Tavares. H2X Racing Promotions Director, Mike Young said, "The event is located in Central Florida, about 45 minutes north of Orlando and a should attract a lot of racers from all over southeastern United States, because this is the first race in Florida this season". He added, "We are coming to Tavares for the first time to put on a show, the city has been very cooperative, and our entire crew is excited to be a part of this Independence Day celebration".

Racers from Southeastern United States will be reaching speeds of 80+ mph, while negotiating a closed course (similar to a grand prix track), all involved in a quest to be a champion!! The American Power Boat Association, of Eastpointe, Michigan, is the sanctioning body and the event is being presented by the City of Tavares and Sea Doo.
